Dear Neighbor,

Please be advised that Genesee County Public Works will be initiating a critical infrastructure project on Dry Bridge Road. To ensure the safety of our crews and the long-term reliability of utility systems, the bridge will be closed to all traffic for several weeks.

Closure Details:

Start Date: Monday March 30, 2026

Estimated End Date: Mid to Late May 2026

Reason for Closure: Bridge widening and structural upgrades to accommodate the new water pipeline installations.

What this means for you:

Detours: Through traffic on Dry Bridge will be redirected. Please follow all posted detour signs and allow for extra travel time during morning and evening commutes.

Local Access: Access for Residents living directly adjacent to the bridge will be maintained as much as possible, though the bridge crossing itself will be strictly prohibited.

Project Scope: This expansion is a vital part of our efforts to improve local water infrastructure, ensuring that our pipeline system has the capacity to serve our growing community safely.

Weather: Please note that weather conditions and unforeseen technical challenges may impact the project timeline. We will provide updates if the reopening date shifts significantly.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we complete these necessary improvements. We know road closures are a hassle, but this work is essential to the future of Alexanders water supply.
